Synopsis: District 7 patrol officers responded to a residence on Fern Street in the McCully area after Emergency Medical Services requested assistance for a medical call. Upon arrival, officers located a 53-year-old female unresponsive inside the residence.

The victim resided in the apartment with her 15-year-old juvenile son.

Detectives from the Homicide Detail responded to the scene, and the case was later reclassified to Murder in the Second Degree after it was determined the victim had suffered multiple stab wounds, to include defensive injuries.

Detectives learned that the 53-year-old victim had a boyfriend who was currently in a the work furlough program and was wearing a court-ordered ankle monitor at the time of the incident.

The victim's family was able to identify the boyfriend as the same male who entered her apartment with her a little after 10:30 a.m., and he was later observed leaving the apartment alone a little after 2:45 p.m.

It has been determined that the suspect took the victim's vehicle

and later arrived at the Kapolei Street residence just before 4:00 p.m., where his estranged wife resides and where he stabbed her. He was arrested in Kapolei for Attempted Murder in the 2nd Degree (Highlight ID #123322).

The suspect fatally stabbed his girlfriend earlier in the day at the residence in the McCully area, took her vehicle, and later drove to the Kapolei area.

Detectives are continuing to review surveillance footage and gather evidence, conduct additional interviews as the investigation remains ongoing.

The suspect has been additionally arrested for Murder in the Second Degree.
