Synopsis: On May 17, 2026, at approximately 2:11 a.m., District 1 patrol officers responded to reports of multiple gunshots fired following a large disturbance in the Kakaako area near Ilaniwai Street and Ward Avenue.

Officers later learned that a 23-year-old male arrived at a nearby hospital with an apparent gunshot wound.

The suspect is described as an African American male wearing a light blue shirt and blue jeans who was seen leaving the area on a yellow motorcycle.

UPDATE

The Criminal Investigation Division's Strategic Enforcement Detail continued this investigation and determined that a large fight broke out after patrons and employees exited The Gatsby bar. During the altercation, three individuals discharged firearms into a crowd of people, striking a 23-year-old male victim.

Detectives identified the shooters as 18-year-old Ezekiel Ramos Hoopai, 32-year-old Trey Samoa and 23-year-old Markelle

Today, May 20, 2026, District 1 CRU arrested Ezekiel Ramos Hoopai and Markelle McFarlin for Attempted Murder in the First Degree and firearm offenses. Trey Samoa has not been arrested at this time and is wanted.

UPDATE

On May 20, 2026, just before 11:30 p.m., the third suspect, Trey Samoa, turned himself into D8 CRU at the Kapolei Station. He was arrested for Attempted Murder in the Second Degree.

UPDATE

On May 22, 2026, this case was conferred with the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney. The suspect, Markelle McFarlin was charged with Reckless Endangering in the First Degree and Place to Keep Pistol. His bail is set at \$100,000. Ezekiel Ramos Hoopai was charged with Place to Keep. His bail is set at \$20,000. Trey Samoa was released pending further investigation.
