Synopsis: On May 19, 2026, at approximately 1235 hours, District 8 CRU officers were attempting to locate a wanted suspect in the area of Kalaeloa when the suspect accelerated a vehicle toward officers, causing them to take evasive action to avoid being struck. During the incident, the suspect vehicle collided with two police vehicles before becoming disabled.

Officers removed the suspect from the vehicle and placed him under arrest. The vehicle the suspect was operating was later confirmed to be stolen.

The 30-year-old suspect was arrested for Attempted Murder on a Law Enforcement Officer, Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle, Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3rd, Resisting Arrest, and a Probation Violation Warrant.

One officer sustained minor injuries during the arrest.

The investigation remains ongoing.

Today, May 21, 2026, this case was conferred with the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney.

The suspect, Dane Lemes-Keller, was charged with Criminal Property Damage 1st Degree, Attempted Assault Against a Law Enforcement Officer, Attempted Assault 2nd Degree, Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3rd Degree, Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle (UCPV) 1st Degree, and Terroristic Threatening in the First Degree.

Bail is set at \$250,000.
